Shade Variations

Subtle shade variations are inherent in all kiln fired products. Job site blending of tile from several cartons is recommended to achieve an even distribution of color range. Final selection should be made from actual current tile samples.

Some quarry tile is produced with a shade variation from tile to tile like in the Somerset line. This classic architectural look (sometimes known as flashing) is achieved through controlling the flow of oxygen and gases in the kiln. Whether monotone or with color variation, all quarry tile colors have a natural look that matches well with other design elements.

Because of the high recycled content in the EnviroQuarry there will be some shade variation from run to run and within longer runs. Final selection should be made from current tile samples and shade variation should be expected.

For installation guidelines refer to the Tile Council of America Inc. Handbook for Ceramic Tile Installation. Metropolitan Ceramic's unglazed quarry tiles require proper maintenance for peak performance. Refer to the Metropolitan Ceramic's Cleaning and Maintenance Guide for cleaning instructions.
